Tabernacle

Some time ago (these things always take more time than you think) we held an open meeting to discuss the position and style of the tabernacle which had been moved from the back of the church to the sanctuary. Eventually, after much deliberation, the working group decided to purchase a tabernacle to better fit the space at the side of the sanctuary and to commission a sanctuary lamp holder from a local artist.

The tabernacle has now arrived from Italy and there is a little bit of work to be done to make the space ready, which will be done this week, and the new tabernacle will be installed as soon as possible thereafter. I am sure it will be a fitting addition to our beautiful church and to the liturgy.

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.

A 'Walk of Christian Unity' this Sunday, 20 January. The 'Walk' will start at 3 pm prompt with the first of three short, 15 minute services in St Mary's-Greyfriars' Church of Scotland. The 'Walk' will then continue onto the River of Life Church by Dumfries Station finishing at St John the Evangelist, Dumfries followed by a time of fellowship and refreshments. It is hoped people (and children) will bring a lantern or a torch to light us round to the other two churches.

Collection Envelopes

Rite of Presentation

We will celebrate the Rite of Presentation in St Andrew's this Sunday at 10 am Mass. All those whose will be confirmed in February are expected to attend this Rite of Presentation.

Sacramental Preparation

The Sacrament of Confirmation in the Diocese of Galloway is celebrated by children who have just begun Primary 4. There is a sacramental preparation programme in St Andrew's Primary and St Columba's Primary. If you are not at a Catholic school there is a programme in each parish. There can also be some children who are above P4 but have yet to make their Confirmation, again please let Fr Gerald and the parish catechists know.
